Text *and* Video Messaging

- **Contacts**



Allows easy access and editing

Used for email, iMessages, FaceTime, etc.

Uses any email account or **Apple ID email**

- **Messages**



iMessage content can include text – photos – video

Sent between iPad – iPhone – iPod Touch

Account uses **Apple ID email**

- **FaceTime**



Make WiFi video calls using **Apple ID email**

Sent between iPad – iPhone – iPod Touch

Use front camera (face-to-face) or back (360°)

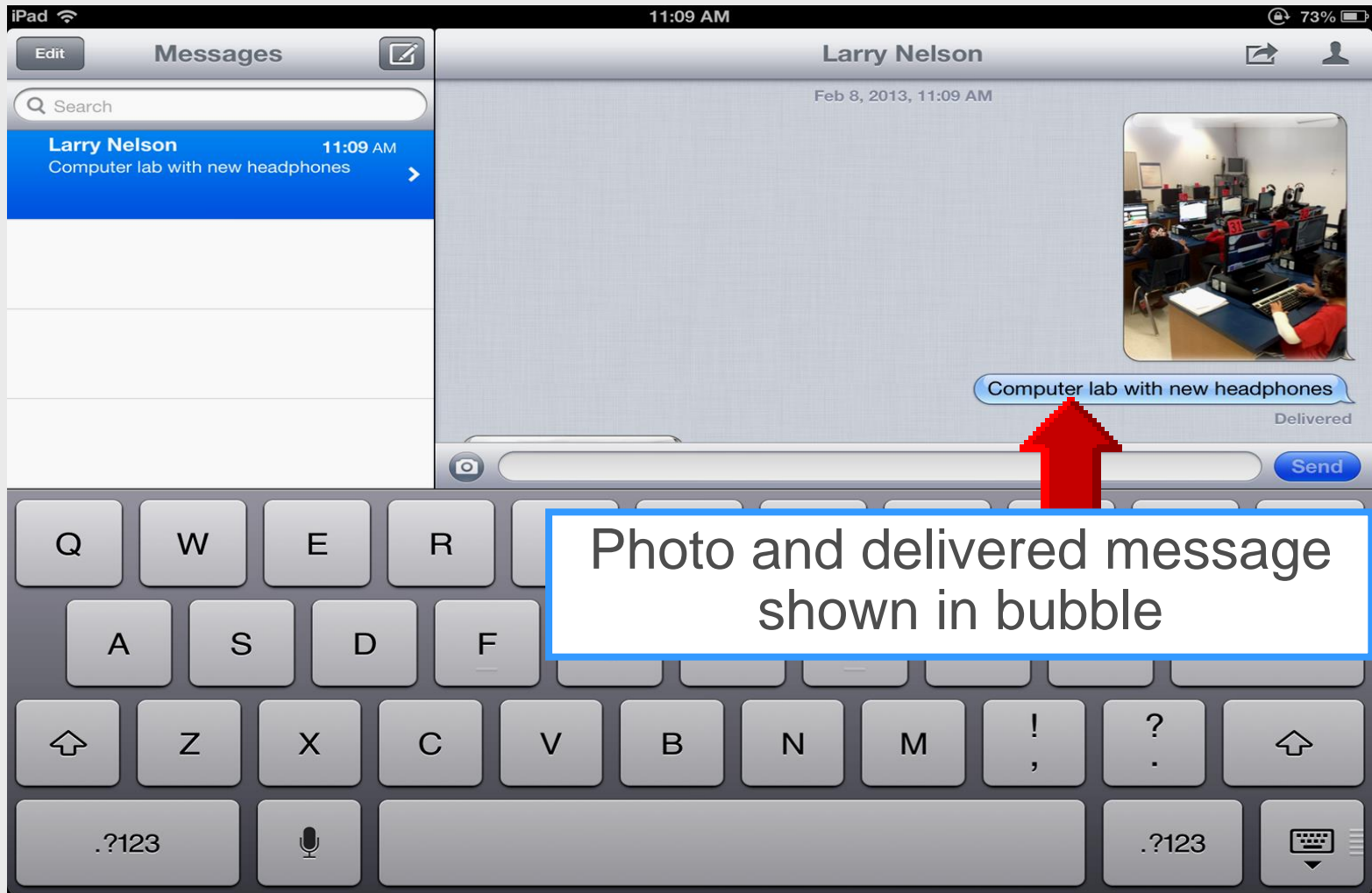
